Diagram showing recorder fingerings for notes C, D, E, F, and F#.

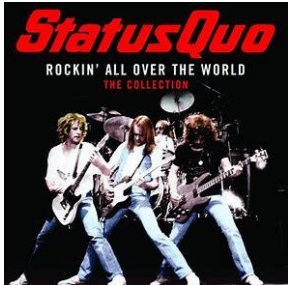
Diagram showing recorder fingerings for notes G, A, B, C, and D.
