There are 99 names for Allah mentioned in the Qur'an. Muslims are taught the importance of knowing them and reciting them in order. • Muslims are called to pray by 5 times a day. The Muezzin recites the Adhan from the minaret at Mosque so all Muslims in the area can hear. • Mecca is an important place to Muslims. It is where Muhammad was born and the direction that Muslims face when they pray five times a day. Muslims are expected to make a pilgrimage to Mecca once in their lifetime. • Christians say the Lord's prayer which asks God for forgiveness. Christians pray in different ways. • Christians believe: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> -God is with them, listening when they want to talk to him. -God is like the best kind of parent. They can talk to him about everything. -Jesus taught his disciples to pray by teaching them The Lord's prayer.
