





All places of pilgrimage are considered to be sacred and holy and they can be places where miracles have taken place. <u>Christian Pilgrimages</u> There are different views on pilgrimage in Christianity. For some Christians, going on pilgrimage is important, whereas others do not believe it is that important. Christians who go on pilgrimages visit places that are in the New Testament in the Bible, or are linked with saints or miracles. Pilgrimages include Lourdes in France and Bethlehem. <u>Muslim Pilgrimage</u> In Islam pilgrimage is important. All three types of Muslims (Sunni, Shia and Sufi) take pilgrimages. Each group of Muslims has its own pilgrimages but they all believe in a special pilgrimage called Hajj. All Muslims try to go once in their life, as this is the fifth pillar of Islam. For Hajj, Muslims travel across the world to visit Mecca.
