Resurrection	Means 'raising up'. Christians believe that God raised Jesus up from the dead after he was crucified.	 <p>Church A place to pray, sing and celebrate. Often built in the shape of a cross.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • A crown of thorns was put on Jesus' head. He had to carry his own large wooden cross up a hill. At the top of the hill, Jesus was nailed to the cross, with nails through his hands and feet. Jesus was left on the cross to die. • On the third day after Jesus' crucifixion, the stone of the tomb had been rolled away. His body was gone from the tomb and an angel told Mary Magdalene that Jesus had risen from the dead. • Christians believe that there is life after death. They believe that the soul leaves the body and enters a new place. They may go to Heaven, where God is. • Many different faiths believe in life after death: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Muslims believe in an afterlife. When they die they await judgment and if they have lived a good life, go to God. ○ Buddhist believe that their energy passes into another form and that are reincarnated. ○ Humanist do not believe in God so try to live a good life whilst on earth. They believe that they will be remembered by others.
