Days of the Week/ Introduction to BSL:

- Sign language is a visual means of communicating. Gestures, body languages and facial expression are used. It is used mainly by people who are deaf or have hearing impairments.
- British Sign Language (BSL) is the most common form of sign language. It has its own grammar and is structured in a different way from English.
- BSL was recognised by the UK government as a minority language in 2003. This led to increased funding and awareness.
- In 2022, British sign language was legally named as an official language of Britain.
- Fingerspelling is the BSL alphabet. Fingerspelling alone isn't sign language, but it can help you to communicate with someone who is deaf.
