Often built in the shape of a cross.		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> On Palm Sunday, Jesus rode on a donkey into Jerusalem, people cut branches from the palm trees and placed them on the ground in front of him. This was as a sign that they believed his message and that he was King. The leaders in Jerusalem were jealous. Many priests were jealous of Jesus and wanted to see him arrested. One of Jesus' disciples (Judas Iscariot) betrayed Jesus for 30 silver pieces. Jesus knew this at the Last Supper. Jesus ate his final supper with his disciples. He told them at the meal that he knew one of them had already planned to betray him. Jesus picked up some bread and told the disciples: "This is my body. Take it and eat it and remember me." He picked up the wine and said: "This is my blood. Drink it and remember me." Jesus went to the Garden of Gethsemane to pray whilst the disciples slept. Judas led guards to Jesus and identified Jesus to them by kissing him. Christians believe that Jesus' death was a sacrifice and offers them forgiveness from God. With Jesus' help they can do their best to forgive other people.
