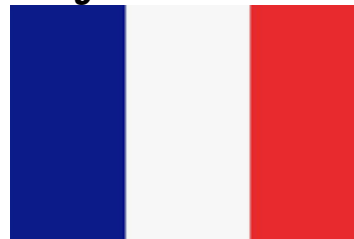
Food/ Introduction to French:

- France is a country in Europe. It has a population of over 62.2 million (2018). The capital of France is Paris. Its borders touch Germany and Belgium in the north, the Atlantic Ocean in the west, and the Pyrenees Mountains and Spain in the south. It also borders the Mediterranean sea in the southeast, and the Alps, Switzerland and Italy in the east. France has a very diverse landscape.
- The national flag of France: "tricolour" (three-colour) flag. The three colours are sometimes said to represent the following: blue – freedom, white – equality, red - brotherhood
- The currency in France is the Euro.
- Traditions: France is famous for its elegant pastries, cheeses and wines. Also for music, art, film, fashion, literature and sport.
