

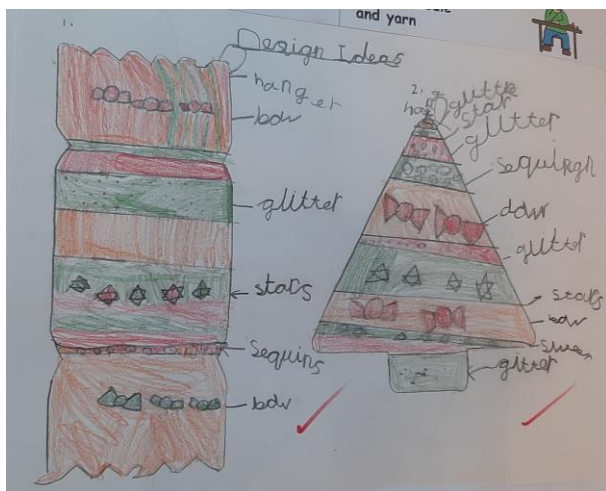

Introduction to Weaving Knowledge Organiser



Vocabulary

- Observe – Look carefully and notice things
- Loom - A device that holds the warp threads in place so the weft can be woven in neatly.
- Warp - threads run up and down
- Weft – threads run from side-to-side (think: right and left)
- Weaving – moving the weft threads over and under the warp threads to make new fabric
- Yarn – a long thread made from fibres
- Designer - a person who thinks of new exciting ideas
- Reflect - Think about your work and how successful you were
- Evaluate - Think about what you would do next time
