Food/ Introduction to German:

KS1 children will learn how to say different **foods** in German using the key vocabulary. Germany is a country in Europe. It shares borders with nine countries - France, Luxembourg, Denmark, Belgium, Switzerland, Austria, Czech Republic, the Netherlands and Poland.

Travel: The quickest way to travel to Germany is by plane. It takes about 1 hour and 45 minutes from London. You can get a ferry and then a train to Germany too. You can also use the Eurostar.

Compare to the UK: The UK is in the northwest of Europe. Germany is in north-central Europe. In the UK, we speak English, Welsh and Gaelic. In Germany, they speak German. The UK flag is red, white and blue. The German flag is black, red and gold.

Tourist attractions: Cologne Cathedral is the tallest twin-spired church in the world. The Branderburg Gate is a national symbol of peace and unity. The Reichstag Building has a roof terrace dome that offers views of the parliamentary and government district. The Marienplatz is a central square in the city centre of Munich where tourists can take in the sights, sounds and sample food.

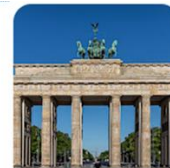
A flight from London/UK to Germany takes about 1 hour 45 minutes.
